- 1. To read the notice calling the meeting
- 2. President's address
- 3. To approve and adopt the minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 30th September 2019 circulated along with the mail dated 9th March, 2020 convening the Budget General Meeting.
- 4. To ratify the Revised Budget Estimate (RE) 2019-20 and Budget Estimate (BE) 2020-21 circulated to the members on 9th March, 2020. The Budget General Meeting scheduled on 30.3.2020 was not held as club was closed as per the Government's directive on account of Covid. Approval was sought for a Capital Expenditure of Rs. 33.33 lakh in the Revised Estimate for 2019 2020 for CAO's Residence. The Capital Expenditure incurred being Rs. 38.38 lakh, the Revised Budget may please be changed accordingly. With this correction, Members are requested to ratify the RE 2019-20 and the BE 2020-21.
- 5. To consider, pass and adopt the report of the Managing Committee and Audited Accounts for the financial year ended 31st March 2020 attached at **Annexure I**.
- 6. To appoint Auditors for the financial year 2020–2021 and fix their remuneration.
- 7. Reference may please be made to the mail sent to members on 10th July, 2020 informing the decision taken by the Managing Committee to levy Rs 2,500 per member to cope up with the difficult financial situation on account of closure of the club and its activities due to Covid. It is further proposed that the existing yearly subscription of Rs 4,500 as per Bye Law 11 (a) & (b), be enhanced to Rs 7,000 from the Financial Year 2021-22 and 10%, rounded off to the nearest hundred, every year thereafter.
- 8. Amendment to Bye Law 11: It is proposed to change the due date for payment of Annual subscription as given below which may please be approved.

9. Payment for usage of the facilities (Pre-payment instead of post payment as at present):

As per the powers vested with the Committee under Bye Law 27.1, it was agreed to by the General Body at the BGM held on 28.03.2019 to limit the credit limit of members to Rs 20,000 per month. The dues from the members are huge on a regular basis and club at the present financial position is finding it difficult to carry on some of the routine functions. It is therefore proposed by the Committee to stop the credit facilities and make it mandatory to pay in advance as the members wish as per their requirements. Accordingly once the amount paid in advance is exhausted, usage of club facilities will not be allowed to such members until they recharge amount.

Once the proposal is approved, Bye Law No 17 will be applicable only for the subscription to be billed in the months of April. Accordingly necessary changes will be made to Bye Law No 17.

10. To consider and, if thought fit, to amend the existing Bye - Law, as given below, with or without modifications;

#### **EXISTING**

#### 8. ELECTION OF MEMBERS:

#### 8.1 Resident Permanent Members

- (e) If the Committee decides to proceed further, as per sub clause (d) a photocopy of the Bio-data Form shall be exhibited on the club Notice Board for not less than fourteen days.
- (f) Within the said period of fourteen days, any Permanent Member having any objection shall submit his/her objections in writing.
- (g) On the expiry of the said period of fourteen days, the Proposal cum Bio-data form shall be put up at the next meeting of the Committee and the objections if any shall be considered. If found in order, a ballot shall be taken by the Committee to decide on admitting the candidate as a Member. At least five elected members of the Committee should be present for the Ballot. Two dissenting votes shall negate the election. The number of dissenting votes shall not be disclosed. In the case of those applicants who were offered Temporary Membership or Long Term temporary Membership, the approval process will be completed after completion of their Membership as a Temporary Member or Long Term Temporary Member.

#### **PROPOSED**

#### **8. ELECTION OF MEMBERS:**

#### 8.1 Resident Permanent Members

- (e) If the Committee decides to proceed further, as per sub clause (d) a photocopy of the Bio-data Form shall be exhibited on the Club Notice Board for not less than fourteen days and also circulated to all Permanent Members by e-mail giving them 14 days to convey objections, if any.
- **(f)** Within the said period of fourteen days, any Permanent Member having any objection shall submit his/her objections in writing to the Honorary Secretary/CAO.
- (g) On the expiry of the requisite period of fourteen days, the Proposal cum Bio-data form shall be put up at the next meeting of the Committee. If found in order, the candidate will be admitted as a Member. Objection's if any, will be deliberated by the Committee and if required, a ballot shall be taken. Atleast five elected Members of the Committee should be present for the ballot and majority dissenting votes shall negate the election. In the case of Long Term Temporary Member (LTTM) applying for Permanent Membership as stipulated in Bye Law No 5.3, the admission process shall be completed if the eligibility criteria as per Bye Law No 5.1 is met and there will not be a ballot as that process was already done while admitting as an LTTM.

- 11. As per Bye Law No 26(g) "All discussions held at the Committee meeting shall be recorded in the Minute Book maintained for the purpose". It is proposed to replace it by "All discussions held at the Committee meeting will be confidential and will not be disclosed to others. The relevant portions of the discussion will be recorded in the minute book maintained for the purpose".
- 12. To elect seven members to form the Committee for the Term of years 2020-2021 to 2021 -2022.
- 13. Any other business: It may be noted that as Bye Law 29.1(b)(v), (c) & (d):

Bye – Law. 29.1 (b) (v): Any business of a routine or complementary nature, such business is "Any Other Business". Notice of such business brought forward by a member shall be submitted to the Honorary Secretary / C.A.O. in writing at least seven clear days prior to the Annual General Meeting.

Bye – Law. 29.1 (c): No special business shall be brought forward unless notice thereof has been given in accordance with Bye – Law 3(j).

Bye – Law. 29.1 (d): Any Member seeking any clarification whatsoever on the Statement of Accounts as referred to in Bye Law 28 (e) shall submit in writing the clarification sought to the Honorary Secretary / Chief Administrative Officer at least ten days prior to the AGM.

#### **INTER-CLUB AFFILIATIONS**

Affiliation was given to National Liberal Club, London during the year and with this, we have affiliation with 71 Clubs across the country and abroad, one in Colombo and the second one in London.

#### **ACCOUNTS**

Deficit during financial year 2019 – 2020 was Rs. 37.84 lakh compared to Rs. 28.42 lakh during the previous year, an increase of Rs 9.42 lakh, major portion of which was on account of depreciation and liquor license fee. The cash deficit for the year was Rs 4.48 lakh as against Rs 3.34 lakh in 2018-19. Capital expenditure of Rs 121.90 lakh was incurred during the financial year for construction of CAO's quarters, new kitchen building and equipments, relaying of synthetic tennis court and flood lighting etc.

The Finance & Accounts Sub-Committee keeps a strict vigil on the accounts. Management Accounting Report presented to the Committee at its monthly meeting is scrutinised in detail and corrective measures, where ever necessary, are taken. This has helped in adhering to the budgets approved.

#### **TAXATION**

**Luxury Tax:** The review petitions (Appeals), filed in the year 2009, for the assessment years from 1991-1992 to 2001-2002 by the Commercial Tax Officer, Coonoor, before the High Court of Madras is pending disposal.

#### Income Tax:

- 1) Appeal filed in Supreme Court in the matter of levy of income tax on the interest received from bank deposits for the assessment years 2001-2002 to 2007-2008 is still pending.
- 2) The Income Tax Appeal for the Asst. year 2006-2007 is pending disposal before the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal, Chennai.

- 3) The assessment orders for the assessment years 2008-2009 to 2013-2015 are yet to be received.
- 4) The income tax liability up to assessment year 2019-2020 were fully paid.

**Wealth Tax:** The appeal filed before the Supreme Court is pending disposal.

Contingent liabilities towards Luxury Tax and Wealth Tax have been kept aside in separate designated Funds. However the actual liabilities towards these two items needs to be ascertained to evaluate the fund position more accurately. The Auditor has been advised to compute the actual liabilities to date on these accounts.

#### **CHAMBERS**

The chambers were refurbished and some of the old furniture changed. The rooms are well patronized. Member and guests occupying the chambers have appreciated the food, services and up keep given positive comments. However it would be our endeavour to improve further wherever possible.

#### **CATERING**

Quality of the food provided to the members and guests are well appreciated.

#### BAR

The bar is well stocked with imported as well as Indian brands catering to the need of all section. The bar is well patronized.

#### PROGRAMS AND ENTERTAINMENT

Special dinners on regular Saturdays, Gala night dinner and special programs on last Saturday of every month and special lunches on Sundays attracts good turnout of members, guests and children. The Entertainment Committee organises interesting musical programs and plays on regular basis.

Special occasions like Deepavali, Onam, Christmas & New Year eve are celebrated in befitting manner which are patronized in good numbers by members and guests.

#### **ANNUAL DAY**

The 'Annual Day' was celebrated on Saturday, 25<sup>th</sup> May 2019. Annual tournaments had good participation from members and their children. The Annual day dinner followed by a live band was well attended.

#### **LIBRARY**

The Library is well patronized and new books are procured with the help of our regular readers. The Club gets popular magazines and periodicals in addition to different news papers. The Committee appreciates the efforts of a few members for the commitment and time spent for betterment of the library.

#### GARDEN

The garden well maintained and appreciated by all. This year as well, the Club garden received first prize at the Annual Flower Show.

#### **SPORTS AND GAMES**

Member & Guests play billiards, snooker, badminton, tennis and table tennis regularly. Card games bridge & rummy are very popular, especially among the elderly members.

#### **AUDITORS' REPORT**

#### TO THE MEMBERS OF COONOOR CLUB, COONOOR

#### **Opinion**

We have audited the financial statements of **Coonoor Club** ("the Club"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at **March 31, 2020**, Income and Expenditure Account for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information for the year ended on that date.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Club as at **March 31, 2020**, and of its financial performance for the year then ended, prepared in all material respects in accordance with The Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.

#### **Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our audit in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Club in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements, and we have fulfilled our other responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

#### Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Managing Committee is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements in accordance with The Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act, 1975, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Club's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Club or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so. Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Club's financial reporting process.

#### Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that

includes our opinion. NOTES ON ACCOUNTS: SCHEDULE: 24

#### A) Basis of preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements of the Club have been prepared in accordance with the generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India [Indian GAAP] on accrual basis under the historical cost convention.

The preparation of financial statements requires the management of the Club to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported balances of assets and liabilities, revenues and expenses and disclosures relating to contingent liabilities. The Management believes that the estimates used in preparation of the financial statements are prudent and reasonable. Actual results could differ from these estimates. Any revision to the accounting estimates is recognized prospectively in the current and future periods. Estimates include provisions for employee benefit plans and provision for income taxes.

#### B) Entrance Fees

Entrance Fee of Resident and Outstation Members are recognized as Capital Receipt and accounted in the ratio of 65% and 10% as Capital Receipt and transferred to Building and Infrastructure Fund and Corpus Fund respectively. 25% of Entrance Fee is recognized as Revenue Receipt and transferred to General Fund.

#### C) Revenue Recognition

Revenue from subscriptions from Outstation Permanent Members, Resident Members and Long Term Temporary Members is recognized as income on accrual basis. Income from sale of liquor, catering, games and other facilities is recognized net of taxes on accrual basis on billing of members. Interest income is recognized on accrual basis.

#### D) Fixed Assets

Tangible assets are stated at original cost, net of tax/duty credits availed if any, less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses recognized where necessary. Costs include all expenses incurred to bring the assets to its present location and condition. Subsequent expenditure relating to fixed assets is capitalized only if such expenditure results in an increase in the future benefits from such asset beyond its previously assessed standard of performance.

Assets retired from active use and held for sale are stated at the lower of their net book value and net realizable value and are disclosed separately in the Balance Sheet.

Intangible Assets are recorded at the consideration paid for acquisition and are carried at cost less accumulated amortization and Impairment Losses if any.

#### Additions to Building:

During the current financial year club has increased facilities to the existing building and has additional cash outlay of Rs.73,44,089. The details of the outflow towards various construction activities are detailed.

To equalize the Fund Accounts an amount of Rs.73,44,339 was transferred from Building and Infra Structure Fund to General Fund. This has been done in confirmatory with the Clubs accounting treatment of fund accounts.

#### E) Depreciation and Amortization

Depreciation on Assets has been provided on written down value method based on the useful life of the assets. Depreciation on additions/ deductions is calculated pro-rata from/ to the date of additions/ deductions.

#### F) Inventories

Inventories are valued at lower of cost and net realizable value. Cost is determined on First in First out (FIFO) basis. Cost includes freight, taxes, duties and other charges incurred for bringing the goods to the present location and condition and are net of VAT/GST credit, where applicable.

#### G) Employee Benefits

#### **Defined Contribution Plan**

Contributions to Employee's Provident Fund is deposited with the Government and the Club's contribution to the funds is charged to revenue.

#### **Defined Benefit Plan**

Provision for Gratuity has been made as per the provisions of Payment of Gratuity Act 1972 and the Club is not maintaining any contributory plan.

#### Other Employee Benefits

Other Employee Benefits are estimated based on the terms of the employment contract.

#### H) Taxes on Income

a. Current Tax is the amount of tax payable on the Interest Income for the year and is determined in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

b. The Judgment in the Madras High Court was not in favour of the Club and our appeal is pending before the Supreme Court.

The total tax liability of Rs. 8,52,416 pertains to the financial year 2018-19 corresponding to the Asst-Year 2019-20 have been charged to the various fund accounts on the basis of the ratio of interest earned on the deposits as detailed below:
