TAXATION

Luxury Tax The Writ Petitions filed before the Honorable High Court of Madras had been decided in favour of the Club.

The Department of Commercial Taxes represented by the Commercial Tax Officer, Coonoor, had filed a second appeal in the Honorable High Court of Madras. The appeal is pending disposal.

Income Tax:

1) In the matter of levy of income tax on the interest received from bank deposits, an appeal has been filed for the Assessment years 2001-2002 to 2007-2008 in the Supreme Court and is pending.

2) The Income Tax Appeal for the Asst. year 2006 – 2007 is pending disposal before the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal, Chennai.

- 3) The assessment orders for the assessment years 2008- 2009 to 2013- 2015 are yet to be received.
- 4.) The total liability towards Income Tax up to assessment year 2020-2021 have been fully paid. (Refer Notes on account H (d) of schedule 24).

Wealth Tax: The appeal on Wealth Tax Matters is pending decision of the Supreme Court.

AUDITORS' REPORT
TO THE MEMBERS OF COONOR CLUB, COONOR

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of **Coonor Club** ("the Club"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at **March 31, 2021**, Income and Expenditure Account for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information for the year ended on that date.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Club as at **March 31, 2021**, and of its financial performance for the year then ended, prepared in all material respects in accordance with The Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Club in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements, and we have fulfilled our other responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Managing Committee is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements in accordance with The Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act, 1975, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Club's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Club or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so. Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Club's financial reporting process.

A) Basis of preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements of the Club have been prepared in accordance with the generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India [Indian GAAP] on accrual basis under the historical cost convention.

The preparation of financial statements requires the management of the Club to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported balances of assets and liabilities, revenues and expenses and disclosures relating to contingent liabilities. The Management believes that the estimates used in preparation of the financial statements are prudent and reasonable. Actual results could differ from these estimates. Any revision to the accounting estimates is recognized prospectively in the current and future periods. Estimates include provisions for employee benefit plans and provision for income taxes.

B) Entrance Fees

Entrance Fee of Resident and Outstation Members are recognized as Capital Receipt and accounted in the ratio of 65% and 10% as Capital Receipt and transferred to Building and Infrastructure Fund and Corpus Fund respectively. 25% of Entrance Fee is recognized as Revenue Receipt and transferred to General Fund.

C) Revenue Recognition

Revenue from subscriptions from Outstation Permanent Members, Resident Members and Long Term Temporary Members is recognized as income on accrual basis. Income from sale of liquor, catering, games and other facilities is recognized net of taxes on accrual basis on billing of members. Interest income is recognized on accrual basis.

D) Fixed Assets

Tangible assets are stated at original cost, net of tax/duty credits availed if any, less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses recognized where necessary. Costs include all expenses incurred to bring the assets to its present location and condition. Subsequent expenditure relating to fixed assets is capitalized only if such expenditure results in an increase in the future benefits from such asset beyond its previously assessed standard of performance.

Assets retired from active use and held for sale are stated at the lower of their net book value and net realizable value and are disclosed separately in the Balance Sheet.

Intangible Assets are recorded at the consideration paid for acquisition and are carried at cost less accumulated amortization and Impairment Losses if any.

Additions to Building:

During the current financial year club has increased facilities to the existing building and has additional cash outlay of Rs. 6,44,837.62. The details of the outflow towards various construction activities are detailed.

E) Depreciation and Amortization

Depreciation on Assets has been provided on written down value method based on the useful life of the assets. Depreciation on additions/ deductions is calculated pro-rata form/ to the date of additions/ deductions.

F) Inventories

Inventories are valued at lower of cost and net realizable value. Cost is determined on First in First out (FIFO) basis. Cost includes freight, taxes, duties and other charges incurred for bringing the goods to the present location and condition and are net of VAT/GST credit, where applicable.

G) Employee Benefits

Defined Contribution Plan

Contributions to Employee's Provident Fund is deposited with the Government and the Club's contribution to the funds is charged to revenue.

Defined Benefit Plan

Provision for Gratuity has been made as per the provisions of Payment of Gratuity Act 1972 and the Club is not maintaining any contributory plan.

Other Employee Benefits

Other Employee Benefits are estimated based on the terms of the employment contract.

H) Taxes on Income

a. Current Tax is the amount of tax payable on the Interest Income for the year and is determined in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

b. The Judgment in the Madras High Court was not in favour of the Club and our appeal is pending before the Supreme Court.

The total tax liability of Rs. 8,74,069 pertains to the financial year 2019-20 corresponding to the Asst-Year 2020-21 have been charged to the various fund accounts on the basis of the ratio of interest earned on the deposits as detailed below:

I) Provisions, Contingent Liabilities And Contingent Assets

Provisions involving substantial degree of estimation in measurement are recognized when there is a present obligation as a result of past events, and it is probable that there will be an outflow of resources. Contingent liabilities are not recognized but are disclosed in the notes. Contingent assets are neither recognized nor

disclosed in the financial statements. The Liability in respect of following pending litigation before the Tax Authorities are not determined and disclosed.

a. Wealth Tax:

The appeal on Wealth Tax Matters is pending decision of the Supreme Court.

b. Luxury Tax:

The Writ Petitions filed before the Honorable High Court of Madras, had been decided in favour of the Club.

The Department of Commercial Taxes represented by the Commercial Tax Officer, Coonoor, had filed a second appeal in the Honorable High Court of Madras. The appeal is pending disposal.

J) Others

a. During the year a net amount of **Rs.1,97,591.67** [Previous year Rs.1,19,478.00] which is irrecoverable from Ceased and Deceased members account has to be written off.

b. President Mr. Phillip Mathew welcomed the members to the Extraordinary General Meeting convened to seeking members approval to amend the Bye- Law for administrative purpose.

3. To consider and, if thought fit, to add a new Bye – Law to be numbered as 5.7 as below.

5.6: BUSINESS CLASS MEMBERS:

Managers & Assistant Managers employed in plantation within the revenue district of Nilgiris between the ages of 21 years to 60 years of age may be admitted as "Business Class Members", subject to confirmation in writing by the authorized signatory of the plantation company concerned confirming the candidates employment. The membership will cease on resignation, retirement and or transfer from the district. Business Class Members will be entitled to all privileges of a regular member during their period of membership, except voting rights and the right to propose or second candidates for membership. (PS : Refundable deposit payable will be Rs.50,000/- and Annual Subscription will be Rs.6,000/-. This will be appropriately recorded in the Annexure to the Bye - Law.)

On having discussion on this matter the President explained to the floor about the necessity to amend this Bye-law, since in earlier days the plantation company itself pays the deposit fee for membership. Now the sponsorship has been stopped. The eligible candidates finds difficult to pay the deposit amount from their salary. So the basic idea is to make the youngsters use the club which increases the revenue of the club.

Mr.H.S.Metha and Mr.S.N.Raju strongly opposed this new proposal. They stated that the idea to increase the revenue of such membership should be studied in detail.

Finally it was decided to give the Membership with the Refundable deposit payable of Rs.1,00,000 /- and Annual Subscription Fee Rs. 4,500/-. The age limit to become a member is up to 30 years.

8. ANY OTHER BUSINESS:
